



Information on moving in during the Corona pandemic

Dear tenant,

We look forward to welcoming you soon as a tenant in one of our student residences. As you will be aware, our daily lives are being affected by the coronavirus pandemic. This letter provides you with important information. Please read it carefully and follow the rules listed below in order to protect yourself and others.

- Wearing a mask is mandatory in many public places (e.g. on public transport; in shops, banks, restaurants, etc.; when you visit doctors, public authorities, etc.). You must also wear a mask whenever you have an in-person appointment with one of our caretakers.
- You **must** follow the hygiene guidelines that are in place for our student residences!
- Persons who do not follow coronavirus rules may have to pay considerable fines.
- Please check with your university to find out if your courses will be taught remotely or face-to-face.
- If you have to quarantine, please let us know.

If you are having symptoms that are typical for coronavirus (e.g. high temperature; cough; loss of, or change in, sense of smell or taste; etc.), please do not move in to your apartment until your symptoms have gone.

Currently, special rules apply for persons travelling to Germany and, in particular, for persons who enter Germany from a high-risk area.

Currently, the rule is that persons who enter Germany from a **high-risk area** will have to quarantine for about **10 days (early termination for vaccinated and recovered persons with detection immediately with transmission or PCR test earliest after 5 days quarantine)**.

Currently, the rule is that persons who enter Germany from a **area of variants of concern** will have to quarantine for about **14 days (no early termination possible)**.

In addition, they will have to inform the local health office (*Gesundheitsamt*) of the address in Germany where they will be staying; to do so, they will have to use the so-called passenger locator card.

If you have to quarantine, please read the following information carefully and follow the rules listed below:

- Go directly to your apartment after you have received your keys; keep a safe distance from others and wear a mask over your mouth and nose until you have entered your apartment!
- You are not allowed to leave your apartment until your quarantine is over. This means that you are not even allowed to go shopping or take out your rubbish. Please let us know as soon as possible that you have to quarantine. You can have food and drinks delivered. See below for a list of grocery stores that offer online order services as well as food and drink delivery services.
- Sanitise the door handles and surfaces in your apartment at regular intervals and open windows to air your apartment at regular intervals.
- - Remember that your apartment does not come equipped with kitchen utensils. This means that you will need to get cutlery, pots, pans, etc.
